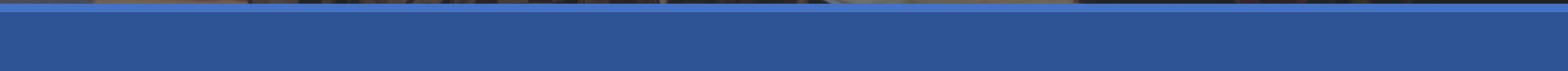

Peralta Colleges Health Services

All students pay an 18 dollar health fee and are eligible for a range of health services if they attend any college in the Peralta system. Records are kept confidential and only medical staff will have access. Services include:

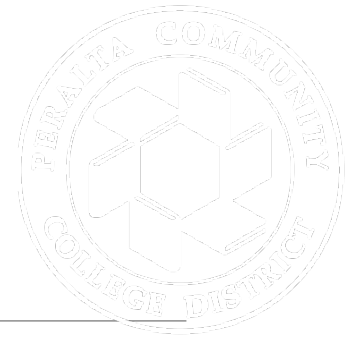
HIV testing
